# Scope of Policy

- i. Adequate discharge planning with connection to outpatient OAT provider
  - OAT and anti-craving medications
- ii. Counselling/therapy is part of treatment programs but unclear whether it is evidence based, and structured
  - Training of counsellors or individuals working at the facility
  - Motivational interview training
- iii. Mechanism for admission standard
  - Lengthy process
  - Access from pre-screening perspective
  - Referrals to residential care normally come from the individual with the substance use disorder
- iv. Tobacco use
- v. Communication to primary care/psychiatry/IM
- vi. Inclusion of medical care ie Hep/HIV etc
- vii. How do we have evidence-based addiction medicine processes within recovery facilities?
- viii. Equitable access to recovery centres
  - Your ability to get this type of support and recovery, but does not depend on where you live

- ix. Language used when referring to these facilities and what criteria should establish a recovery centre as a recovery centre
  - Define what a recovery centre is
  - Inpatients support addiction treatment centres
  - Inpatient addiction treatment programs
- x. Highly advocate that you have to be interconnected before you are released or kicked out transition of care
  - The reactions of other individuals within the facility must be accounted for
